The best blinds for uPVC conservatories. Available as roller, pleated or venetian blinds.



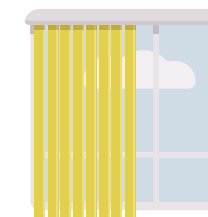
## Venetian Blinds

Always popular as you can slant the slats to block sun glare but still allow daylight into your conservatory.



## Roman Blinds

# Perfect Fit Blinds



## Easy to fit

Perfect Fit blinds clip onto the uPVC frame. No drilling or screwing is necessary.



## No cords

No dangly cords are required to operate these blinds. Just push up or pull down.



## Roller blinds

Choose from hundreds of colours and patterns.



## Pleated blinds

Pleated blinds look like Venetian blinds but give the total privacy of a roller blind.



## Venetian blinds

You can close the blind for privacy but slant the slats to let daylight in.



## Suitable for doors

As they are attached to the door frame, they won't blow in the wind if the door is open.

As they can be made with PVC, wood or aluminium, they suit all styles of home and decor.



## Versatile

The blinds can be down, up, or partially down. When down, the slats can be moved to a position that suits you.





# Roman Blinds
