ISIT WORTH HAVING A SIMPLE, HANDWRITTEN WILL?

In the short term, or in a critical situation, having a <u>simple</u>

<u>handwritten Will</u> in place may be better than having no Will at all, but we always advise you to consult a solicitor as soon as possible.

HOWTO WRITE YOUR OWN WILL

WE WILL GIVE YOU AN EXAMPLE OF A VERY SIMPLE WILL

- It assumes that the person <u>making the Will</u> (the testator) wishes to leave everything to her husband, otherwise to her two children.
- It can be copied, handwritten and amended to suit your own circumstances.



I full name residing at address hereby make my Will:

- a. I appoint my husband full name residing at address (whom failing my son full name residing at address and my daughter full name residing at address) to be my executor.
- b. I leave my jewellery to my daughter full name residing at address.
- c. I direct my executor to pay £1,000 to each of my grandchildren full names residing at addresses.
- d. I direct my executor to pay £1,000 to Charity
- e. I direct my executor to make over the residue of my estate to my husband name (whom failing to my son name and daughter name equally between them).
- f. I direct my executor to make over the residue of my estate as follows:
 - 50% to my son and daughter equally between them
 - 25% to my brother name residing at address
 - 25% to Charity.

WILL CRITICAL POINTS

- The Will MUST be signed and dated.
- If it goes onto more than one page, it must be signed by the testator at the bottom of every page.
- Appoint an executor(s).
- Include a clause dealing with the residue of the estate.
